



What is EnviroMed?

EnviroMed is an eco-friendly medical supply and shipping company that targets medical facilities interested in prioritizing sustainability by reducing carbon emissions, switching to more eco-friendly materials, and utilizing better packing.

US hospitals produce more than 5.9 million tons of waste each year. They spend more than \$760 billion annually on tossed waste. This poses two problems for hospitals. The first problem is a revenue loss for companies and the second is environmental damage for local residents. PPEs are currently made of non-sustainable materials.

Our goal is to help combat these problems by providing an alternative product made using seaweed that is more environmentally friendly. EnviroMed PPE products are designed to be biodegradable and are produced, shipped, and packaged sustainably.
